

**Professor Michael Archer** from the University of New South Wales recently came to AIPAH to talk to our students. He is the leading Palaeontologist in Australia (meaning he studies fossils and life from the past). He has been Head of the Australian Museum and Dean of Science at the University of New South Wales.

He came out to present to our students on the fossil history of the planet Earth and discuss evidence of Darwin's Law of Evolution. Students gained a lot from this, and many took the opportunity to ask a multitude of questions related to this - and other topics in Science.

It is unusual for High School students to have access to such an experienced and well rounded professional scientist. The visit gave the opportunity for students to see science as a worldwide endeavour and not just something that is 'dead' in the classroom.
